Lif: I don't know.


Phil: Look at his ears!

Lif: What is it, Dad?


Father Wolf: It's a man cub.

Lif: He's so funny. Look, he's smiling!




Ip the cub.

Lif: Here are some flowers for you.


Mowgli: Thanks, Lif!
